Webcast / Service Recording (Downloadable link only)	£80 / £60
A person aged 18 + (Living outside of above counties, Mon-Fri).....	£859
Additional length of service time (Mon-Fri)	£230
Saturday Service (Up to and including 11:00am).....	£1026
Unattended Cremation (Limited availability of times, normal fee applies other times)	£483

Chilterns Crematorium

Cemetery Fees – April 2022

In addition to the above, these are the fees for interment in a grave space within one of the local cemeteries – Woodwells (Hemel Hempstead), Kingshill (Berkhamsted) & Tring.

Burial fees are normally made up of two costs – the fee for the interment, and the fee for the Exclusive Right of Burial, or “purchase” of the grave.

Exclusive Right of Burial Fee

Usually referred to as the purchase fee, you are not actually purchasing the plot, but securing the right to have your loved one buried there.

Interment Fee

This is the fee charged by the council to open the grave, make it ready for the deceased to be buried, to complete it afterwards and to record the interment in their register.

Interment in full lawn grave	£675
<i>If there is a memorial on the grave already, this will have to be removed before interment, and will incur a further charge.</i>	
Interment of cremated remains	£230

NOTE: These fees are subject to change dependant on whether the deceased or the applicant for the burial is or was (at the time of their death) a resident in the borough of Dacorum. Non-residents should expect the fees to be triple those listed above.
